

OBJECTIVES:

- To unify all veterans under the Federation;
- To perpetuate and memorialize the heroic deeds of our veterans and inculcate to the youth love of country and patriotism;
- To expand and improve the Federation's revenue base;
- To institutionalize good corporate governance in the Federation;
- To provide quality, responsive and accessible services to veterans;
- To conduct strategic review of its Charter and/or its CBL to make it responsive to the changing needs and aspirations of all veterans through member-organizations.

FUNCTIONS:

- Formulate an aggressive recruitment program in order to entice the veterans to organize or join existing veteran's organization;
- Formulate a retention mechanism of member-veterans organizations;
- Document the wartime experiences of veterans and veterans' organizations;
- Lobby for declaration of significant historical wartime sites and the establishment of shrines in coordination with the NHCP and other government agencies;
- Partner with LGUs and other government agencies in the celebration of commemorative activities;
- Maximize the revenues generated from the Federation's assets;
- Strengthen accountability mechanism especially in the utilization of funds and other resources for the veterans;

- Exercise functional supervision over all veterans organizations;
- Increase the competency level of the organization (include training, recruitment, succession planning, and all other aspects of HR management and development);
- Determine the aspirations and needs of veterans and veterans member-organizations;
- Conduct periodic Organizational Development review to keep the VFP in-step with the changing times;
- Promote mutual help, undertake charity and relief work among its member;
- Partner with NGOs and other institutions to enhance the socio-economic well-being and medical needs of its members
