CENTENARIAN CASH GIFT

INSTRUCTIONS:

A. Eligibility - Be in good standing. A member in good standing is one who complies with the duties and responsibilities prescribed by the VFP, to include payment of membership dues, and does not perform acts derogatory and inimical to the interest of the VFP.

B. Scope and Coverage:

1. Grant of Centennial Cash Gift of Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00) shall be one-time basis only.
2. It shall apply to a living veteran who reaches the age of one hundred (100) years old and above and must be a member in good standing of VFP.

C. Documentary requirements:

1. Duly accomplished application form to avail the Centenarian Cash Gift duly endorsed by the Post/Charter/Affiliate President.
2. **Original copy** of birth certificate issued by Philippine Statistic Authority (PSA) or Local Civil Registrar (LCR) with registry number or if authenticated, it must be **authenticated original copy with an official dry seal** of the Local Civil Registrar (LCR) or original copy of any government document duly authenticated with an official dry seal by the Local Civil Registrar (LCR).
3. Photocopy of VFP membership ID card, AFP Retiree ID card, and PVAO Pensioner ID card.
4. Three (3) specimen signatures of the applicant member. If thumbprints, it shall be certified in the presence of two (2) dis-interested persons or Post President and Brgy. Captain.
5. **Original copy** of Barangay Certificate as proof that the veteran at present is still living.
6. Picture holding front page of the latest newspaper showing a clear or readable date together with the original copy of newspaper.

D. Duties and Responsibilities of the Charter, Affiliate, and Post Presidents:

1. Shall certify by way of endorsing the application that the member/recipient is a member in good standing and all the documentary requirements submitted by the applicant **as listed in paragraph C are authentic.**
2. Shall submit the accomplished application form and original documentary requirements and send thru mail courier, LBC or any fastest means of communication to the National Headquarters, Veterans Federation of the Philippines (VFP).
